FAIRHAVEN HISTORICAL COMMISSION DECEMBER 4, 2013

Previous minutes read and accepted.

No financial report.

Academy roof was damaged in an earlier storm and has been repaired. Estimates will be solicited by David to have the south exposure replaced. A discussion was made regarding whether the CPC proposal for the shades was eligible. It was agreed that due to the shades preserving the interior surfaces that the proposal should go forward.

Wayne and Bill Roth met earlier at the Fire Museum to review the proposal involving interior work. The CPC differentiates between projects involving routine maintenance and preservation. It is felt by the Commission that the preservation work, particularly the windows, should be eligible.

Gary reported on the conclusion of the major cleanup at the Fort. Various trees, weeds, and vines have been removed. Gary also reported on a NSTAR proposal that will retrofit the Fort lights with led's. The company will pay one half of the costs. The new lighting would save approximately 60 percent of utility costs. The Fort gates are being closed from 7:30pm to approximately 7:30 am every day.

The Old Stone School gutters have been cleaned and treated.

The Annual report was read and accepted with minor corrections.

The 192 Green Street form is to be picked up at the Library and taken to the sign painter. Deb is to review the 7 Walnut St form.
