Academy Report; Roof estimates have been received, John Mansville is the low bidder. Vote made to submit a request to Town meeting in the amount of \$8,000. The CPC proposal for the shades has been revised to reflect the need to preserve the interior surfaces of the building from UV rays.

Fire Museum Report; members of the CPC committee met at the building on 12/28 to view the proposed work. Ms McNaughten recommended that the Commission tour all buildings in the spring.

Fort Phoenix Report; Gary Lavolette reports that vandalism continues to be an issue at the Fort. He will be meeting with Jeff Osuch and a representative of NSTAR to discuss lighting upgrades. Mr. Lavolette has a reflective jacket to wear while volunteering at the Fort, he will contact the selectmen's office to determine an appropriate marking for the same. The signage at the Fort was discussed with an idea to make it all of a uniform design. The cleat on the flag pole was also discussed; Mr. Lavolette will meet with Chuck Cromwell to decide a method of repair.

The annual report and budget have both been submitted to the Selectmen's office. A vote was made to increase the requests for the Academy and the Fort by \$500 each.
