Town Manager introduction: Mr. Rees was unable to attend.

Previous minutes: Read by Mr. Despres, approved on a motion by Mr. Lavalette/seconded by Mr. Oliveira.

Financial report: Read by Mr. Despres, approved on a motion by Mr. Lavalette/Ms. Paquette.

Academy building report: Mr. Despres reported that the CPC approved the exterior repair grant. Mr. Lavalette reported that the plasterer has been working in the classroom. Staging has been set up on the second floor, which will be worked on next.

Fire Museum report: Mr. Oliveira reported that interior painting is planned for spring at the Spring St. site. Mr. Despres reported that the Washington St. doors have been repaired.

Fort Phoenix: Mr. Lavalette reports that there have been no issues over the past month.

Old Stone School: Mr. Despres notes some weathering to the roof shingles.

House Plaques/Historical Markers: no submissions for this month.

Other CPC grants: Mr. Lavalette states that the Academy front door will have to be addressed at some point.

2017 budget: Mr. Despres reports that the plan, per the Town Accountant, is to combine all accounts into one HC account.

Other business: Mr. Brady, in attendance with other Bell Committee members, asked if the HC had any questions regarding the bell placement. Mr. Despres reiterated that this decision is within the purview of the Bell Committee and stated that as this topic is not on the agenda, no official discussion may take place.
