Academy Building report: CPC has approved the exterior project, it will now go before Town Meeting for approval. Mr. Lavalette reports that the interior plaster repair and painting has been completed.

Fire Museum report: Mr. Oliveira reports nothing new at either site.

Fort Phoenix: Mr. Despres will contact the architect regarding rebidding the parapet project. Mr. Lavalette reported that the spotlight at the fort has been vandalized. A temporary repair will be attempted with a led replacement to be sourced.

Old Stone School: nothing new to report.

House Plaques/Historical markers: 20 William St. is still being researched. An application for 66 Spring St has been received, Ms. Charpentier will review it.

Future projects: Mr. Despres reported that the Old Stone School roof is showing wear on the south exposure. A discussion also took place regarding the condition of the Academy main entrance door. A potential project could include a door replacement in conjunction with new lighting. Both projects will be discussed further.
