Financial report: read and accepted on a motion by Mr. Oliveira/Ms. Isaksen.

Academy building report: Mr. Despres thanked Ms. Isaksen for the plaster repairs. The CPC grant is to be voted on at Town Meeting.

Fire Museum report: Mr. Oliveira reports nothing new at either building.

Fort Phoenix report: Mr. Despres contacted Clearwater Architects regarding the parapet rebidding, have not received a reply. Mr. Lavalette reported on a vandalized light. A replacement lens would be 36 dollars, a replacement led light would be 2,300 dollars.

Old Stone School report: Mr. Despres spoke with a member of the Garden Club. Mulch will be supplied to assist with their efforts.

House plaques/Historical markers: The Whitfield house plaque has been installed. Mr. Rooney asked for copies of the research, Mr. Despres will supply. 20 William St research not complete. 66 Spring St research is complete. The plaque will read, "Capt. Charles Christopher Harris. 1855". Approved on a motion by Mr. Oliveira/Mr. Lavalette. Ms. Charpentier will contact the homeowners.

Future projects: both the Old Stone School roof and the Academy entrance doors were mentioned. The projects will be discussed later this year for possible future CPC grants.

Membership updates: the resignation of Mr. Richard has left an opening for a full member. Associate member Vicki Paquette expressed an interest in becoming a full member. She was proposed for full membership by Mr. Despres, second Mr. Lavalette. Mr. Despres will contact the Selectboard regarding the Commission recommendation.
