Blue Stream Shellfish -Solar upweller & FLUPSY request:

Mr. McNamara gave a recap of the gathering held at the West Island Community Center and the decision to update the proposed location to Hoppy's Landing. Dale Leavitt spoke and explained the new proposed location that would not be as visible to the residents of West Island. This would be a temporary location through the end of 2023 and they would look for a permanent location for next spring. Discussion ensued amongst the board with pros and cons. Several residents made public comments and asked questions. *Motion* by Mr. Jones to recommend to the Select Board to accept the plan adjacent to Hoppys Landing not to exceed six months or end of calendar year. Mr Hebert seconded. Unanimous vote. (6-0-1)

Harbormaster Updates:

New Signs referencing 15 minute limit for dock came in and will be installed. Larger sigh will be updated also. Hoppy's Landing will by all pay parking lot as of July 1, 2023. Signs will be made and information will be advertised. Trailer and car parking designated areas will remain the same. Tim explained the process and how it will be patrolled. Discussion ensues regarding Off the Hook's capacity and the overflow parking. Update given on Union Wharf's timeline of construction and that the boats will be displaced. Tim displayed map and explained what area will be repaired.
