

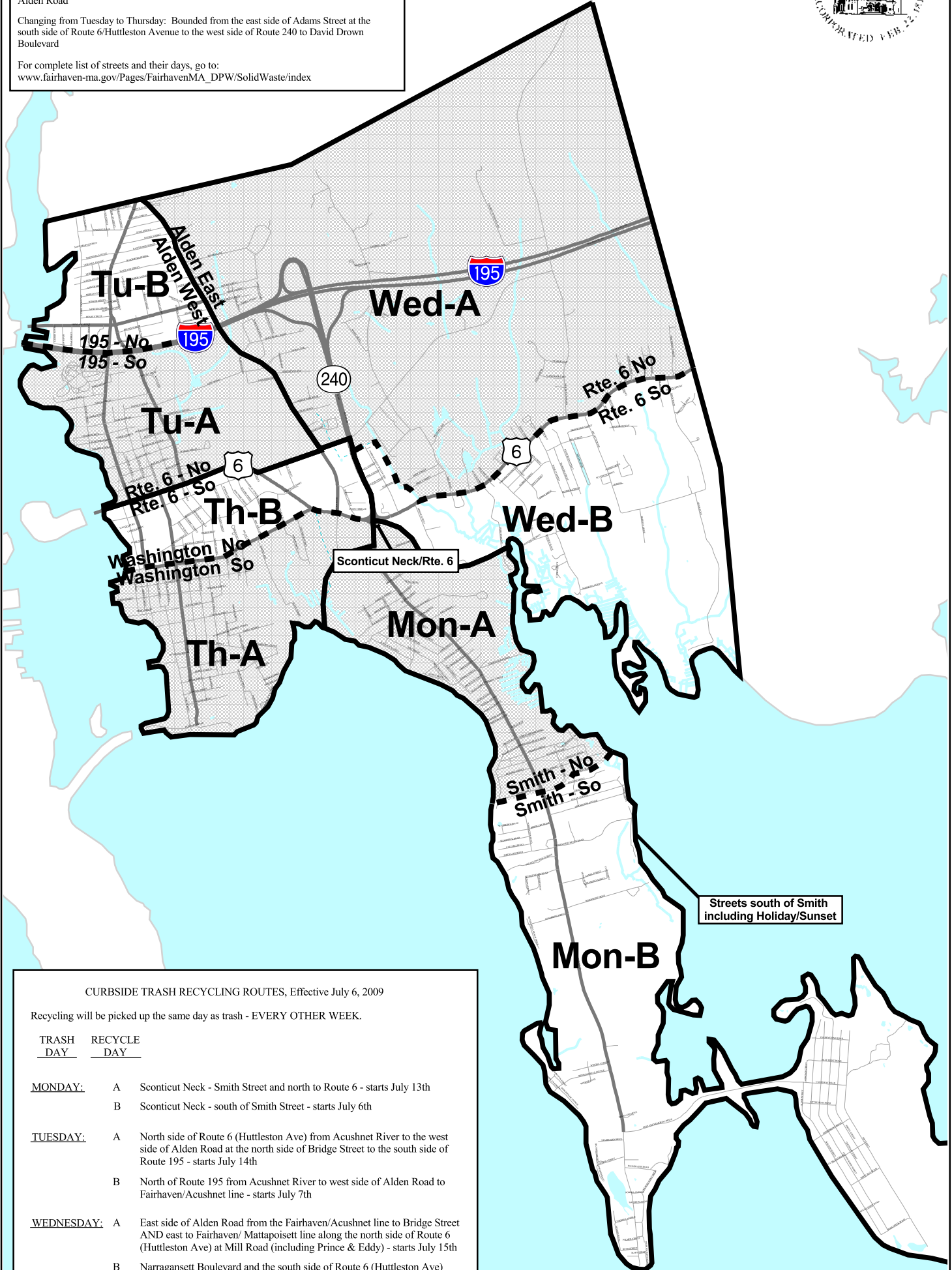
Trash and Recycling Route Changes - Starts July 6th, 2009

Changing from Wednesday to Tuesday: Bounded by north side of Howland Road to west side of Alden Road to the Acushnet line and easterly to the Acushnet River.

Changing from Tuesday to Wednesday: Bounded from Howland Road at the east side of Alden Road to Route 195 along Route 240 to Bridge Street and west to the east side of Alden Road

Changing from Tuesday to Thursday: Bounded from the east side of Adams Street at the south side of Route 6/Huttleston Avenue to the west side of Route 240 to David Drown Boulevard

CURBSIDE TRASH RECYCLING ROUTES, Effective July 6, 2009

Recycling will be picked up the same day as trash - EVERY OTHER WEEK.

TRASH DAY	RECYCLE DAY	ROUTE
MONDAY:	A	Sconticut Neck - Smith Street and north to Route 6 - starts July 13th
	B	Sconticut Neck - south of Smith Street - starts July 6th
TUESDAY:	A	North side of Route 6 (Huttleston Ave) from Acushnet River to the west side of Alden Road at the north side of Bridge Street to the south side of Route 195 - starts July 14th
	B	North of Route 195 from Acushnet River to west side of Alden Road to Fairhaven/Acushnet line - starts July 7th
WEDNESDAY:	A	East side of Alden Road from the Fairhaven/Acushnet line to Bridge Street AND east to Fairhaven/ Mattapoissett line along the north side of Route 6 (Huttleston Ave) at Mill Road (including Prince & Eddy) - starts July 15th
	B	Narragansett Boulevard and the south side of Route 6 (Huttleston Ave) from Route 240 to the Fairhaven/Mattapoissett line - starts July 8th
THURSDAY:	A	South side of Washington Street to Fort Phoenix AND Acushnet River to the east side of Route 6 (Huttleston Ave) - starts July 16th
	B	North side of Washington Street to south side of Route 6 (Huttleston Avenue) AND Acushnet River to west side of Route 240 - starts July 9th
