The FY26 Budget Public Hearing of the School Committee Meeting was called to order by Mr. Veitch at 7:22 pm.

FY26 Budget:

Superintendent Kohler presented the FY26 Budget to the School Committee (Attachment A) and reiterated that our FY26 NSS requirement is \$25,777,688, the Town Placeholder is \$25,256,166 which is \$521,522 below Net School Spending. The Committee continued to discuss possibilities of cuts and possible solutions.

Public Comment:

Mr. Padraic Elliot, Chair of the Finance Committee and Mr. Robert Grindrod member of the Finance Committee addressed the Committee with their concerns and different ideas regarding the FY26 Budget and look forward to the Joint meeting on April 10, 2025 to discuss further.

Reports & Recommendations from the Superintendent:

Fairhaven High School Storage Facility

Superintendent Kohler attended the Town Department Head meeting yesterday and asked the Building Commissioner for the exact response deadline to the letter he sent regarding the occupancy concerns. He stated the deadline to submit a response is April 18, 2025.

Superintendent Kohler, Mrs. Potter, Building Commissioner Forand, and Interim Town Administrator George Samia met separately regarding the Storage Facility project. Superintendent Kohler presented a historical overview of restroom plans, bids, Historic Commission involvement, and documents shared with the commissioner.

Two pathways for resolution were discussed. Option A: Complete current shed construction once the court case has been cleared up and Option B: Demolish current structure and build original restroom/storage plan; funding options may have to be Capital Planning.



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The ongoing legal dispute update was that the Land court hearing took place; final resolution may come by mid/late May.

Mrs. Pickup asked about the cost of the two options regarding the storage facility. Superintendent Kohler stated the first option with the retrofit bathrooms will be approximately \$50,000. Mrs. Pickup also asked who will be responsible for the legal fees as well as the cost of any damaged materials if we win the court case, etc. Superintendent Kohler will look into that.

Mr. Monroe asked about the progress on emptying the containers. Superintendent Kohler stated she had initially run into Mr. Carr at the Town Hall and he stated he was cancelling our contracts and to empty the containers. She stated the cancellation has been rescinded by Erin Carr.

Upcoming Events:

Joint meeting with the Finance Committee will be held April 9, 2025. The next School Committee Meeting will be held April 30, 2025 at 4:30 pm.

Questions from Individual Committee Members:

Mrs. Pickup mentioned the Lagao Friendship Pact finally had a meeting. They are restructuring and welcoming the community to join.

Mrs. Pacheco asked about the cut of Esser Funds. Superintendent Kohler stated we were told we were originally going to be cut \$250,000, which was going to the Outdoor Classrooms as well as an HVAC study. She then stated the State updated them to continue as usual until further notice. Mrs. Pacheco asked about the Outdoor Classrooms. Assistant Superintendent Balestracci noted they are just finishing up some permitting issues. He has been working closely with Building Commissioner Forand.

Mrs. Pacheco asked about the Certificate of Completion for former eligible alumni of Fairhaven High School. Assistant Superintendent Balestracci stated he is working on a QR code in order to get the information out to the public and be able to audit their transcripts to see if they have met the current competency determinations

Motion made by Mr. Monroe to adjourn Open Session Meeting, seconded by Mrs. Andersen, roll call vote, approved (6-0).
