Dear Commission Members,

On behalf of the applicant, EM & CM Family Limited Partnership, c/o Connie Martin, please find the following documents for the above-referenced filing of a Notice of Intent under the state's Wetlands Protection Act and its regulations at 310 CMR 10.00 and the Fairhaven Wetlands Protection Bylaw et seq.:

- Two (2) copies of the WPA Form 3 Notice of Intent with attachments.
- Two (2) full size and two (2) 11x17 copies of accompanying plan "Site Plan for Proposed Addition at 215 Alden Road in Fairhaven, MA" by Outback Engineering, Inc. dated June 30, 2025.

- Check in the amount of \$150.00 payable to the Town of Fairhaven to cover the Local Bylaw filing fee.

Project Narrative: The applicant is proposing to add a 900 sf addition and 30sf covered entry to their house at 215 Alden Road in Fairhaven MA. All the proposed work is located within the 200' Riverfront area of an unnamed stream that runs off property to the north. The addition is proposed to be located on the north side of the house in an area that is currently lawn and landscaping. Approximately 125 sf of the 200' outer riparian zone and 805 sf of Inner Riparian Zone will be permanently disturbed by the installation of the proposed house addition. Approximately 1600 sf of lawn and landscaping will be temporarily disturbed during construction and restored once the project is complete. The total permanent alteration within the Riverfront area is 930 sf which is approximately 2.05 % of the total Riverfront area on site (45,171 sf) and is below the 10% alteration which may be allowed per 310 CMR 10.58(3)(d)(1). A Riverfront Alternative Analysis with more details is enclosed in this application. Silt fence has been proposed for erosion control and will also act as the limit of work on the project. Disturbed areas within the limit of work are proposed to be stabilized with loam and seed.

Step 4/Subtotal Activity Fee: Multiply the number of activities (identified in Step 2) times the fee per category (identified in Step 3) to reach a subtotal fee amount.
