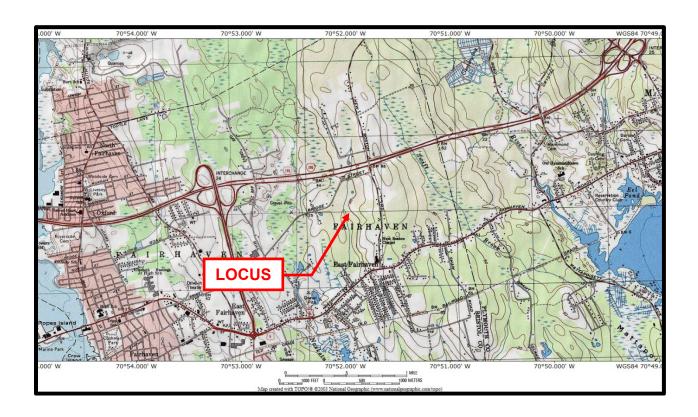

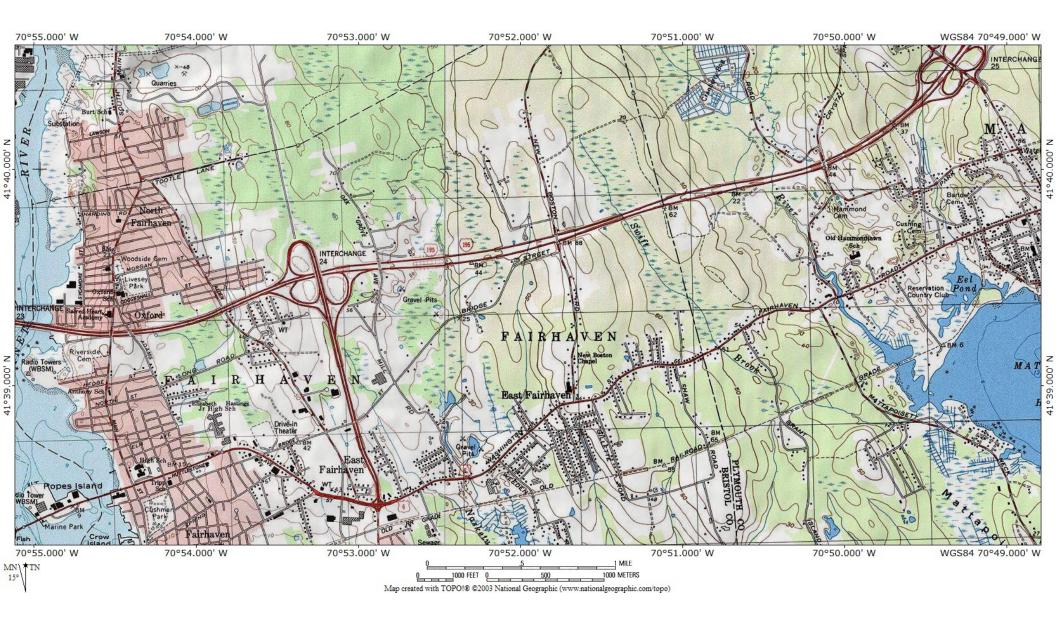

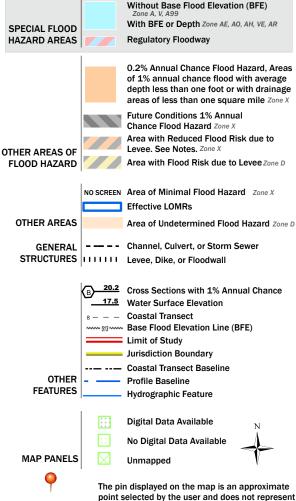

Per your request, Environmental Consulting & Restoration, LLC (ECR) performed a review of the existing conditions at the property located at 483 Bridge Street in Fairhaven (the site) on March 13, 2025. The purpose of the review was to identify wetland resource areas on and near the site. The weather on March 13th was overcast, cloudy, and cold (approximately 40 degrees) with light wind and mostly dry conditions. The site is located to the south of Bridge Street and West of New Boston Road. The site consists of a large lot that is being utilized for various agricultural activities with livestock paddocks, agricultural fields, multiple sheds/barns, fencing, etc.

Wetland resource areas are located throughout the site. ECR placed Bordering Vegetated Wetland (BVW) flags (pink/black striped ribbons) along the landward limits of the following vegetated wetlands:

BVW #A1 to #A50 – Wetland within the southern portion of the site. BVW #B1 to #B72 – Wetland through the northern and western portions of the site. BVW #C1 to #C9 – Wetland within the southeastern portion of the site.

Please note, the wetland between flags A50 and C9 follows somewhere around and/or through the horse paddock. ECR did not delineate the limit of the wetland in the horse paddock due to the presence of multiple horses in that area. The vegetated wetlands were delineated following the methodology established by the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) regulations found at 310 CMR 10.55 pertaining to the delineation of Bordering Vegetated Wetlands. The delineation was performed by analyzing vegetation, hydrology within 12 inches of the surface, and soil conditions within 20 inches of the surface. The wetlands contain hydric soils, saturated soils, and dominant wetland indicator plants.

ECR also located the Inland Bank to a USGS mapped perennial stream located within the western portion of the site. Inland Bank flags (blue ribbons) #IB1 to #IB14 were placed along the limit of the stream in order to identify the 200-foot Riverfront Area that extends over the site.

As a result of ECR's wetland delineation at the site, ECR is able to confirm that the site contains the following wetland resource areas and areas of Conservation Commission jurisdiction:

- Bordering Vegetated Wetlands
- 100-foot Buffer Zone to BVW
- Inland Bank to a perennial stream
- 200-foot Riverfront Area

Also, a review of the MassMapper database reveals the following:

- 1. The site <u>is not located</u> within Estimated/Priority Habitat for Rare Species according to the Massachusetts Natural Heritage & Endangered Species Program (MaNHESP).
- 2. The site <u>does not contain</u> a Certified Vernal Pool according to the MaNHESP. Please note, a mapped potential vernal pool is located within the "B" series wetland, more than 100 feet within the interior of the wetland.
- The site <u>does not contain</u> areas mapped as Land Subject to Flooding according to the FEMA maps.
- 4. The site is not located within an Area of Critical Environmental Concern.

ALTERNATIVE ANALYSIS

Project Overview

- Project: Construction of a single-family dwelling with gravel driveway, septic, utilities, and limited landscaping. It is important to note that even though the project is for the construction of a single-family dwelling, only a small portion of the proposed on-site soil absorption system and associated grading is located in the outer riparian zone. The proposed house and gravel driveway is located outside of the riparian zone.
- Location: 483 Bridge Street, Fairhaven, MA 02719
- Applicant: Donna Jackson-Motta
- **Purpose:** Provide a single-family residence on an existing legal lot while meeting state/local health, setback, and zoning requirements.

Site Description and Constraints

- Parcel size and configuration: 19.9 acres +/-
- **Resource areas present:** Outer riparian (riverfront area) and bordering vegetated wetlands.
- **Existing conditions:** The consists of forested bordering vegetated wetland with pasture fields in the upland areas. An existing seashell driveway off of New Boston Road which then turns into a gravel driveway provides access to the large pasture located toward the east portion of the lot.
- **Physical constraints:** Include narrow frontage off of New Boston Road with substantial wetland areas on either side of the existing gravel driveway.

Alternatives Considered

Each alternative was evaluated for environmental impact to wetland resource areas, practicability (constructability, technical feasibility), and substantially equivalent economic outcome for the applicant.

Alternative 1 — No Build

- **Description:** Do not construct the dwelling; maintain current site condition.
- **Environmental effect:** No direct impact on any wetland resource; highest ecological protection.
- **Practicability / Economics:** Fails applicant's objective to construct a single-family dwelling; economically unacceptable.
- Status: Rejected (environmentally best but does not meet applicant's purpose).

Alternative 2 — Relocate Building

- **Description:** Place proposed development in the field located adjacent to Bridge Street.
- Environmental effect: Avoids direct riverfront impacts.

- Practicability / Economics: May be infeasible due to small area, lack of suitable septic area due to proximity to bordering vegetative wetlands.
 Status: Rejected due to proximity to bordering vegetative wetlands and size
- constraints.
