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Background

Year Built: 1960 Year Renovated: 1990's

Elizabeth Hastings Middle School has one floor and is located at 30 School Street.

Exterior locations surveyed included parking, an exterior ramp, exterior stairs, walkways surrounding the building, two (2) softball fields, two (2) baseball fields, a football/soccer field, and the entrance to the tennis courts. Interior locations surveyed included the auditorium, classrooms, principal suite, two (2) guidance suites, library, cafeteria, gymnasium, boys' and girls' locker rooms, and all multi-user toilet rooms.

Note: The boys' and girls' multi-user toilet rooms across from the principal's suite were locked and unable to be surveyed, however the IHCD team confirmed they were not accessible by looking through the window on each door.

Key Accessibility Issues

Exterior Routes

Accessibility issues include walkways with slopes that are greater than allowed, walkways that are not maintained in operable working condition, routes with level changes greater than allowed, and lack of an accessible route to the garden, all exterior bike racks, and from the egress stairs by the auditorium.

Parking

Accessibility issues include lack of two (2) car accessible parking spaces, lack of one (1) van accessible parking spaces, running slope at one access aisle greater than allowed, parking signage located lower than allowed, and parking signage not maintained in operable working condition.

Stairs

Accessibility issues include exterior stairs with risers that are not uniform, lack of handrails provided on one or both sides, lack of handrail extensions, handrails with noncompliant cross sections, handrails that do not return properly, and stairs not maintained in operable working condition.

Interior Routes

Note: If programs are held in this space during events at the auditorium, including sales of tickets or other goods, an accessible platform lift between the exterior entrance/exit floor level and the auditorium entrance floor level must be provided. If programs similar to these are not held in this area, IHCD recommends providing a platform lift as best practice.

Doors and Doorways

Accessibility issues include doors that require opening force greater than allowed, doors with lack of pull and push side maneuvering clearance, doors that have a clear width that is less than allowed, doors with thresholds not beveled, and doors with noncompliant hardware.

Assembly Areas

Accessibility issues in the auditorium include lack of wheelchair spaces and lack of aisle designation seats. The IHCD team was told that the school has an assistive listening system that they can get from the school district as needed. The Town should ensure that the number of receivers complies with Table 219.2 in the 2010 ADA Standards.

Note: If audible communication is integral to the use of the space, an assistive listening system shall be provided as shall a sign with the International Symbol of Access for Hearing Loss.

<u>Signage</u>

Accessibility issues include lack of signage with the illuminated International Symbol of Accessibility (ISA) at accessible emergency egress doors*, lack of tactile exit signage at all emergency exit doors, and lack of compliant designation signage with raised characters that and braille.

*Note: When the illuminated exit sign at the accessible exit is replaced, an illuminated sign with the International Symbol of Accessibility (ISA) should be provided.

Locker Rooms

Accessibility issues include benches that lack 30" clear floor space next to them, benches with depth narrower than allowed,

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and benches with clearance underneath that is lower than allowed.

Toilet Rooms

Accessibility issues at toilet rooms include lack of accessible urinals and toilet fixtures, lavatories with exposed plumbing, mirrors located higher than allowed, lack of grab bars by toilets, improperly located toilet centerlines, an improperly located toilet flush control, doors with malfunctioning self-closing hinges, and a toilet compartment door with inadequate maneuvering clearance. There is also one noncompliant exterior portable toilet.

Shower Compartments

Accessibility issues include lack of accessible showers and an accessible route to the shower area in the boys' and girls' locker rooms.

See the following diagram from the U.S. Access Board showing an accessible gang shower:



Sinks

Accessibility issues include sinks with lack of toe and knee clearance, sinks with a counter located higher than allowed, and one (1) sink with exposed plumbing.

Note: If no classrooms in a given grade or a given type of classroom or space have a sink, an accessible sink is not required to be provided. It is the presence of a sink in a classroom that triggers the requirement of at least one (1)

accessible sink in the same classroom or same type of classroom.

Areas of Sport Activity

Accessibility issues include lack of an accessible route to five (5) fields, lack of accessible spaces at each spectator seating area, lack of an accessible route to each team seating area and each spectator seating area, and fields not maintained in operable working condition.

Figure 1: In the following image, the yellow line shows one approximate route to connect all fields and areas of team and spectator seating from the parking on the east side of the building to the two baseball fields, the soccer field, and two softball fields:



Additional Accessibility Issues

- Lack of accessible lockers in the school.
- Protruding objects (such as shelves and defibrillators) in the circulation path.
- A defibrillator located higher than allowed.
- Lack of accessible work surfaces.
- Lack of accessible picnic tables located on accessible routes.
- Circulation routes are narrower than allowed.
- Issues with drinking fountains include lack of standing height drinking fountains, noncompliant drinking fountains for seated users and drinking fountains with inadequate water flow.

*Note: IHCD is not providing costs for accessibility renovations for outdoor areas, ramps or stair handrails. Unit costs are provided for one instance of repetitive items.

Best Practice and Inclusive Design

Best practice and inclusive design recommendations include elements that are not required in the standards but may create enhanced experiences for all users.

- Recommend providing blade signs over all fire extinguishers and defibrillators in the building.
- Recommend providing a height adjustable bed in the nurse's office.
- Recommend providing directional signage to the accessible entrance to the stage.
- Recommend providing an adjustable height podium with knee and toe clearance in the auditorium.
- Recommend providing a solid and continuous stripe applied to the horizontal leading edge of each interior and exterior stair tread so that each tread is readily apparent when viewed in descent at each stair in and outside the building.

- Consider providing raised garden beds that have knee and toe clearance for a forward approach for wheelchair users.
- The Commission on Disability mentioned that this school does not have air conditioning. This may make the school difficult for students with sweating disorders and other disabilities. Recommend installing air conditioning.
- Based on a comment from the Commission on Disability, recommend providing adaptive sports equipment.
- Recommend providing a directional sign to the ramp to the accessible auditorium entrance at the auditorium entrance by the toilet rooms.
- Recommend using the term "Accessible Parking" instead of "Handicapped Parking" at all accessible parking signage.
