Background

The Emergency Management Public Safety Annex building is a one-story structure that is located at 150 Sconticut Neck Road. A parking area is located south of the building.

Areas surveyed include entrances, exits, a men's, a women's and a largely accessible all-gender single-user toilet room, a meeting space and a kitchen area.

Key Accessibility Issues

Parking

Accessibility issues include a van accessible parking space and access aisle that are narrower than allowed, and lack of signage with the designation "Van Accessible" at the van accessible parking space. Additionally, the sign with the International Symbol of Accessibility (ISA) is not maintained in operable working condition.

Signage

Accessibility issues include lack of signage with the International Symbol of Accessibility (ISA) at the largely accessible entrance door, lack of directional signage at inaccessible entrance and egress doors directing visitors to the nearest accessible entrance and egress, lack of tactile egress signs, lack of designation signs with raised characters and braille located on the latch side of doors at each permanent room, a sign with glare, and lack of directional signage at inaccessible toilet rooms pointing visitors to the accessible toilet room. Additionally, when the illuminated exit signs at the accessible exits are replaced, illuminated signs with the International Symbol of Accessibility (ISA) should be provided.

Doors and Doorways

Accessibility issues include doors that lack maneuvering clearance, doors that require an opening force greater than allowed, doors with a noncompliant closing speed, doors with thresholds that are higher than allowed, and doors with noncompliant hardware that cannot be used without requiring tight grasping, pinching or twisting of the wrist.

Toilet Rooms

Accessibility issues at the largely accessible all-gender singleuser toilet room include exposed plumbing underneath the lavatory, a mirror located higher than allowed, a noncompliant side grab bar and a toilet that is located further from the side wall than allowed.

Additional Accessibility Issues

- One (1) exterior route and one (1) interior route is not firm, stable and slip-resistant.
- Coat hooks, pamphlets and hand sanitizer dispensers are located higher than allowed.

Order of Magnitude Cost Estimates

- Provide new accessible parking signs: \$1,000
- Renovate doors (including providing two (2) automatic door openers): \$14,500
- Provide compliant signage (designation, informational, directional, and egress): \$4,150
- Locate items within reach range: \$1,075
- Renovate one (1) toilet room: \$5,096

Total: \$25,821*

*Note: IHCD is not providing costs for accessibility renovations to outdoor areas.

Best Practice and Inclusive Design

Best practice and inclusive design recommendations include elements that are not required in the standards but may create enhanced experiences for all users.

- Recommend replacing sign in front of the building.
- Recommend raising the height of the parking lot exit sign so that is it more visible to a person driving from the road.
- Recommend providing a sign that says "Enter" at the entrance to the parking lot.
- Recommend providing a sign that states "Accessible Parking", rather than "Handicapped Parking" at the accessible parking space.
