
# Whitfield-Manjiro House



# Town of Fairhaven ADA Transition Plan

July 2024



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### **Background**

Year Built: 1840 Year Renovated: 2008

The Whitfield Manjiro House is located at 11 Cherry Street and is a three (3) story building. The building's floors are connected by two (2) interior staircases.

The building has one (1) accessible entrance, which is accessed by the ramp on the east side of the building. There is one (1) inaccessible exit on the west side of the building.

Areas surveyed include the gift shop, classroom, kitchen, singleuser toilet rooms and exhibits throughout the second and third floors.

## **Key Accessibility Issues**

#### **Exterior Routes**

Accessibility issues include lamps acting as protruding objects, excessive cross slope, and lack of an accessible route to the accessible entrance.

#### **Exterior Ramp**

Accessibility issues at the exterior ramp include lack of compliant landing, a ramp width that is narrower than allowed, and lack of handrail extensions.

#### **Vertical Circulation**

Accessibility issues include lack of an accessible route to exhibits on the second and third floors. However, there is a large screened television in the first-floor gift shop that plays a virtual tour of the upper levels with captions in English and Japanese.

#### **Exterior and Interior Stairs**

Accessibility issues at exterior stair include lack of compliant handrails on both sides and lack of compliant handrail extension at the bottom of the stair.

Accessibility issues at interior stairs include lack of at least one handrail with a grippable profile between the first and the third floors in the west stair. Additionally, as the east staircase has

winder stairs, IHCD feels that they may be hazardous and recommends that the public use the west stair, rather than the east stair.

#### <u>Signage</u>

Accessibility issues include lack of directional sign at the inaccessible front entrance directing people to the back ramp, lack of a sign with the International Symbol of Accessibility (ISA) at the accessible entrance, lack of interior designation signs with raised characters and braille, lack of tactile signs (with braille and raised characters) at the emergency egresses, and lack of illuminated signs with the International Symbol of Accessibility (ISA) at the accessible emergency exit\*.

\*Note: When the exit sign at the accessible egress doors is replaced, provide an illuminated exit sign with an illuminated International Symbol of Accessibility (ISA).

#### Interior Access Routes

Accessibility issues at interior access routes include lack of 36" clear width, mats not secured to the floor, and vertical clearance that is less than 80" above the finished floor.

#### Doors and Doorways

Accessibility issues include doors that lack maneuvering clearance, and doors with excessive thresholds.

#### Single-User Toilet Room

Accessibility issues at the single-user toilet room include lack of 60" min. clear at the toilet. Additional issues include plumbing underneath the lavatory that is exposed, a paper towel dispenser acting as a protruding object, a mirror above the lavatory that is mounted higher than 40", and noncompliant side and rear grab bars.

#### Kitchen

IHCD was told the kitchen is used for cooking classes. The kitchen would need to go through a large-scale renovation in order to be fully compliant for public use. Until that time, ensure the kitchen itself is only used by staff and cooking steps such as assembly and mixing be done in the classroom.

#### **Additional Accessibility Issues**

- Service counter height higher than allowed.
- Lack of an accessible work surface.

## **Order of Magnitude Cost Estimates**

- Renovate and provide signage (designation, directional):\$4,050
- Renovate toilet rooms: \$32,468
- Renovate doors: \$1,000
- Provide an accessible service counter: \$1,144
- Provide a compliant work surface: \$1,100
- Provide cane-detectable barriers: \$796

Total: \$40,558\*

\*Note: IHCD is not providing costs for certain accessibility renovations, including outdoor areas, kitchen and stair and ramp handrails. Unit costs are provided for one instance of repetitive items (door thresholds).

## **Best Practice and Inclusive Design**

Best practice and inclusive design recommendations include elements that are not required in the standards but may create enhanced experiences for all users.

- Recommend providing visual contrast on all stair treads.
- Recommend providing a print out with photos and descriptions of the exhibit.
