2026 FAIRHAVEN DOG LICENSES

ATTENTION ALL CURRENT DOG OWNERS: Current dog licenses expire on December 31, 2025 and must be renewed by March 1, 2026, or a **\$15.00** late fee will be assessed. **PLEASE NOTE:** Late fees do not apply to dogs being licensed for the first time.

DOG LICENSES CAN BE OBTAINED/RENEWED IN ONE OF THREE (3) WAYS:

- **ONLINE:** Visit www.fairhaven-ma.gov. Click “Pay Bills Online” at the top of the home page, select “Town Clerk”, and choose “Dog License Renewal” or “New Dog License”. Follow the prompts to license your dog. A copy of your dog’s current rabies certificate must be uploaded.
- **IN PERSON:** Visit the Town Clerk’s Office and bring your dog’s current rabies certificate and payment.
- **BY MAIL:** Mail this completed form and the following items to **Town Clerk’s Office, 40 Center Street, Fairhaven, MA 02719:**
 - A copy of your dog’s current rabies certificate (copy will be returned to you)**
 - Proof of spay/neuter, if applicable (often noted on the rabies certificate)**
 - A check payable to: Town of Fairhaven**
 - A self-addressed, stamped envelope (license and tag will not be mailed without it)**

License fees are as follows: Male (M): \$15.00 Female (F): \$15.00
 Neutered Male (NM): \$10.00 Spayed Female (SF): \$10.00
