To whom it may concern,

I am writing to express my serious concerns regarding young children operating motorized bikes on public roads, specifically on Spring Street, Route 6, and local bike paths.

Children around seven or eight years of age are frequently seen riding at high speeds, popping wheelies, and disregarding traffic rules. Many of these young riders lack the situational awareness necessary to navigate cross-traffic, vehicles exiting driveways, and pedestrians safely. Given the public safety emphasis placed on recent initiatives like the installation of Flock cameras, the lack of enforcement surrounding these hazardous driving behaviors is deeply concerning.

I would appreciate information on what measures are being taken to address this safety issue and restrict underage motorized bike use on public streets and multi-use paths.
